Before the start of term, I would like to take this opportunity to remind all parents and carers about the importance of attendance and punctuality.

The vast majority of children attend school on a regular basis and their attendance is never a cause for concern....thank you.

In fact, a number of our pupils celebrated 100% attendance last academic year and we would like to recognise and congratulate them.

Absence from school impacts on achievement, leads to gaps in learning and can affect friendships, all of which can create anxiety and other social, emotional and mental health concerns. Ensuring that your child attends school each day is essential in increasing their chances of achieving well.

From September, this means that if attendance falls below 95% your child will be monitored through our attendance systems. This may mean that you are required to attend meetings in school and complete an Attendance Support Plan.

In addition to the weekly trophy being presented, we will also return to attendance rewards at the end of each half term.

Arrival and Collection

Each morning, the school gates will open at 8:50am. If you are entering the playground, your children are still under your supervision until the classroom doors open. School gates will be closed at 9:10am and any children arriving after this point will need to report to the school office. Each afternoon, the school gates will open for parents at 3:10pm. School finishes at 3:20pm. Children in Nursery and Reception will enter school and be collected via the Early Years gate at the front of school.
